8.2 NOTES 1 and 2:

1 3rd sentence should read: "The higher the value of W or W_{10} , the greater the whiteness.

4th sentence should read: "Equal differences in W or W_{10} values do not necessarily indicate equal differences in perceived whiteness or equal concentration differences of FWA. Similarly, equal differences in T_w or $T_{w,10}$ values do not always represent equal perceptual differences in greenishness or reddishness of whites."

2 The whiteness index is only applicable for specimens whose values of W and T_w (for both 2° and 10° observers) lie within the following limits:

Limited to: $40 < W < 5Y - 280$

Limited to: $-3 < T_w < +3$
