3/4 Inch (19 mm), 0.11 to 0.60 Ounces per Yard (3.4 to 18.6 g/m)

RATIONALE

This document has been determined to contain basic and stable technology which is not dynamic in nature.

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1. SCOPE:

1.1 Form:

This specification covers three classes of para-aramid tape and webbing of a single width and with varying weights.

1.2 Application:

See AMS 3793.

1.3 Classification:

Width of 3/4 inch $\pm$ 1/16 (19 mm $\pm$ 1.6) and weight classes as shown in Table 1.
